Neither does the copying of several sections from Titles 18-B and 4 establish anything of substance in this case.

18-B M.R.S. §§ 201 and 202 require an issue to be properly before the court, which Appellant contends is not the case here.

18-B M.R.S. § 1001 addresses remedies related to a breach of trust. No such issue was discussed at the hearing and the only potential trustee of the Trust at that time was Appellee.

18-B M.R.S. § 412 is inapplicable on its face because the trial court did not alter any of the Trust's provisions.

4 M.R.S. § 252 establishes the probate court's equity jurisdiction which may be "exercised upon complaint according to the usual course of proceedings in civil actions in which equitable relief is sought." Again, this is not the case here.

The holding in Staples v. King is predicated on the plaintiff's invocation of the probate court's equity jurisdiction. <u>Staples v.</u>

King, 433 A.2d 407, 411 (Me. 1981). Again, this is not the case here.

WHEREFORE, Appellant prays that this Honorable Court grant her the relief requested in her initial brief.
