## eFileMaine Submission Requirements

## All documents must:

- □ List the correct docket number (for subsequent filings only)
- **D** Be submitted into the correct court
- □ Be legible and readable
- □ Contain a complete/sufficient electronic signature (MRECS 37) (M.R. Civ. P. 5(f))
- □ Contain a valid Maine Bar Number (this includes all filings, including letters)
- □ Be on the applicable court form in the most current version, if a form exists (MRECS 31(C))
- □ Not be protected by passwords or other security
  - Please note: All court forms are protected. The protection must be removed before uploading. Instructions on removing form security can be found on the <u>About eFile Maine</u> page.
- □ Have only one box checked for MOST DEFINITIVE NATURE OF ACTION in Part IV of the Civil Summary Sheet (CV-001), if the Summary Sheet is required

## Additional requirements:

- The correct filing fee(s) must have been paid (<u>if required pursuant to JB-05-26</u>) (M.R. Civ. P. 5(f)) (MRECS 39(A))
- □ All required documents must be included pursuant to M. R. Civ. P 5(f)
- □ If a motion is filed, a proposed order must be included (if required pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 7)
  - Please note: Proposed orders filed with a corresponding motion must be submitted as an attachment to the motion lead document, or incorporated into the motion itself.
- □ All documents must be submitted as separate PDFs (MRECS 34(A)(2))
- □ All pleadings must be submitted as separate filing codes/lead documents (MRECS 34(A)(2))
- □ The correct filing code(s) must be used
- □ The correct case type must be selected (initial filings only)
- The first resubmission of a rejected filing must include the following information in the Comments to Court section: 1) The words – "Resubmission of filing, original submission unsuccessful." 2) The date of the original attempted submission. 3) The date of this rejection notice. 4) This statement – "This is the first resubmission of [identify the resubmitted document(s)]." Failure to comply with will result in a new and later submission date attaching to the resubmitted document(s).

## Submissions that will be rejected:

- Submissions that do not comply with the above requirements
- Duplicates (documents that have already been submitted and entered)
- Submissions that must be filed conventionally per Rule 34(B)(2) (including documents subject to in camera inspection, record/image barred from electronic transmission or storage by law, including sexually explicit images of a minor, and trial/hearing exhibits)
- Summonses or subpoenas that require a date certain (FED, Personal Property), Contempt, etc.) that do not contain a date certain to appear
- Submissions that the submitting user has requested that the clerk reject
