ORDER ENLARGING TIME FOR RESPONSE TO BRIEFS OF AMICI CURIAE

Bureau of Parks and Lands et al.

Russel Black et al. (collectively Black) have moved to enlarge the time for their response to the briefs of the four amici curiae who each filed a brief on December 15, 2021. Black's appellee's brief is due on January 3, 2022. The motion states that the Bureau of Parks and Lands takes no position on the motion and that Central Maine Power Company and NECEC Transmission, LLC, oppose the motion and believe that Black would "address the [a]ppellant's brief and any supporting amicus briefs in a single [a]ppellee's brief." The Court has not waited for any written response from any other party.

The motion is GRANTED. The time for Black's reply to the briefs of amici curiae is ENLARGED. Black must file his reply to the briefs of amici curiae on or before **January 17, 2022**.
