PURSUANT TO M.R.App.Proc. 4(b)

Defendant-Appellant Roman Catholic Bishop of Portland ("Diocese") moves pursuant to M.R.App.Proc. 4(b) for leave to dismiss the above captioned appeal, as to Plaintiff-Appellee John J.L. Doe only (Business & Consumer Docket No. BCD-CIV-2022-00060), and in support of its motion states the following:

During the pendency of the above-captioned appeal, Plaintiff-Appellee John Doe and Defendant-Appellant Diocese successfully negotiated terms for a full and final settlement of Doe's claims against the Diocese, as originally asserted in the Complaint Doe filed in the Business and Consumer Court, Docket No. BCD-CIV-2022-00060.

Pursuant to the terms of the settlement, the parties have agreed to stipulate to the dismissal of the above-captioned appeal as to Doe, and to Doe's original action in

the Business and Consumer Court. A copy of the Stipulation of Dismissal the parties intend to file in the Business and Consumer Court if the instant motion is granted is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

Doe is one of the thirteen Plaintiffs-Appellees in the above-captioned appeal, and his is the only case as to which the parties intend to dismiss the appeal; the other 12 cases remain unresolved. Doe does not object to the relief requested herein.

WHEREFORE, Defendant-Appellant Roman Catholic Bishop of Portland requests that this Court grant the parties leave to dismiss the instant appeal as to Plaintiff-Appellee John Doe.
