

On or about May 17, 2025, in the City of Lewiston, Androscoggin County, State of Maine, **ROBERT MCCOY** (dob: 07/11/1989), acting with criminal negligence, did store or leave on premises under his control a loaded firearm in a manner that allowed a child under 16 years of age to gain access to the loaded firearm, without the permission of the child's parent, foster parent or guardian, and the child in fact gained access to the loaded firearm and used the loaded firearm in a reckless of threatening manner, used the loaded firearm during the commission of a crime, or discharged the loaded firearm, all in violation of 17-A M.R.S. § 554(1)(B-4)(3).
