Plaintiff-Intervenor/Appellant H.Q. Energy Services (U.S.) Inc. ("HQUS"), pursuant to Rule 10 of the Maine Rules of Appellate Procedure, hereby respectfully requests that this Court grant HQUS leave to present an additional 1 minute of rebuttal argument in this matter. In support of this request, HQUS states as follows:

- 1. This Court, on its own motion, expanded the time for oral arguments to 25 minutes per side, to be allocated among the respective parties.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 11(b) of the Maine Rules of Appellate Procedure, the appellants are allowed to reserve up to 3 minutes for rebuttal. This allowable amount of rebuttal has not, to HQUS' knowledge, been expanded by the Court as of the date of this request.
- 3. Appellants¹ in this matter have agreed among themselves that only Plaintiff-Appellant NECEC Transmission LLC and Avangrid

In addition to HQUS, the Appellants include NECEC Transmission LLC, Avangrid Networks, Inc., Industrial Energy Consumer Group, Maine State Chamber of Commerce, Cianbro Corporation and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Works Local 104.

Networks Inc. ("NECEC/Avangrid") and HQUS shall present oral argument.

- 4. In order to respond to the arguments of Appellees, HQUS seeks leave of this Court to present an additional 1 minute of rebuttal argument. For purposes of clarification, this additional rebuttal time would be included in the total 25 minutes of allocated time.
- 5. If granted, HQUS' rebuttal would be presented in advance of the 3 minutes of rebuttal by NECEC/Avangrid.
- 6. Counsel for all Appellants have consent to this Request. HQUS has not sought the consent of Appellees because this matter relates to the internal allocation of oral argument time between Appellants.

For all of the foregoing reasons, HQUS respectfully requests that this Court grant it leave to present an additional 1 minute of rebuttal arguments during the oral arguments on this matter.
