NOW COMES the State of Maine, by its undersigned attorney and respectfully moves this Court to issue an order directing the defendant, JOHN WILLIAMS, through his counsel, to provide within a reasonable time the following discovery pursuant to M. R. U. Crim. P. 16-A (c)(1) to the attorney for the State:

1. To furnish to the attorney for the State at least 60 days before a testimonial hearing or 90 days prior to the first day of trial at which it will be offered:
  - (a) A statement containing the name and address of any expert witness whom the defendant intends to call in any proceeding; and
  - (b) A copy of any report or statement of an expert, including a report or results of physical or mental examination or scientific tests, experiments or comparisons, which are within the Defendant's possession or control and which the Defendant intends to introduce as evidence in any proceeding.

2. If an expert whom the defendant intends to call in any proceeding has not prepared a report of examination or test, the State requests that such expert prepare, and at least 60 days before any testimonial hearing at which such expert is offered as a witness or 90 days before the first day of trial, a report stating the subject matter on which the expert is expected to testify, the substance of the facts to which the expert is expected to testify, and a summary of the expert's opinions and the grounds for each opinion.

WHEREFORE, the State respectfully requests that its Motion for Discovery may be granted. The State further prays that it may be granted such other and further relief as may be just and proper.
