Effective: March 31, 2022

All of the Justices concurring therein, the following amendment to the Maine Rules for Guardians Ad Litem is adopted to be effective on the date indicated above. The specific amendment is stated below. To aid in the understanding of the amendment, an Advisory Note appears after the text of each amendment. The Advisory Note states the reason for recommending the amendment, but the Advisory Note is not part of the amendment adopted by the Court.

- 1. Rule 10(d) of the Maine Rules for Guardians Ad Litem is amended to read as follows:
 - (d) Approval Procedure.

. . . .

(4) Courses, activities, and programs approved, presented, or sponsored by the Maine Judicial Branch are exempt from the requirement of approval by the Review Board.

Advisory Note - March 2022

Subdivision (d)(4) is added to specify that courses, activities, and programs approved, presented, or sponsored by the Maine Judicial Branch are exempt from the requirement of approval by the Review Board.
